FUNDO DE ACESSO SUSTENTÁVEL AS ENERGIAS RENOVÁVEIS EM MOÇAMBIQUE

The Foundation for Community Development (FDC) and GIZ through the Energising Development (EnDev) and Grüne Bürgerenergie (GBE) Programmes in Mozambique, launch the first call for proposals from FASER, "Fund for Sustainable Access to Renewable Energy", a Results-Based Financing Fund (RBF) and invite companies to submit proposals until the 13th of September 2019.

The objective of FASER is to stimulate the value and distribution chain of renewable energy (RE) technology markets in Mozambique and promote a broader adoption of such technologies across the country, thereby contributing to the efforts of the Mozambican government to achieve the ambitious target of providing universal energy access by 2030.

The Fund promotes the dissemination of high-quality energy technologies into off-grid peri-urban and rural areas, as well as an increased uptake of these technologies by women. It furthermore aims at assisting particularly vulnerable populations to have access to reliable and modern energy.

The fund will act as a catalyst in order to create clean and sustainable energy markets, with a multi-sectoral approach, encouraging the active participation of the private sector, as well as stimulating productive uses of energy.

The RBF Fund consists of multiple funding windows, which are specific to the distinct beneficiaries and expected results of the funders of the RBF. Currently, the RBF has the following windows: The access window focuses on providing access to energy to households. The Productive Use window focuses on providing solutions to SMEs for the productive use of energy. The third window is designed to ensure that no one is left behind and specifically targets regions affected by humanitarian crises, in Manica and Sofala Provinces, which have been hit by cyclone IDAI.

Suppliers and distributors of decentralized renewable energy technologies and energy solutions for productive use are eligible for the RBF Fund. Implementers may be individual entrepreneurs, companies, associations, cooperatives, partnerships and/or consortia between local and international companies that carry out activities with the aim of selling eligible technologies to end consumers on a commercial basis.
