After giving birth I had to cook inside my house. Thanks to Chitetezo Mbaula I did not suffer from too much smoke.

Chitetezo Mbaula protects my house: my roof will not catch fire in the windy season because the flames are contained in the stove (Rumphu)

Chitetezo Mbaula protects my chitenje and keeps my food clean.
