Solar power for mobile phone masts and households



Objectives

Solar-based energy supply to mobile telephone

Measures

- Mobile masts as anchor points for electrification
- Energy provider operates Antenna (jointly developed operating model)
- Sale of Energy to nearby villages via prepaid meter system

Results

- Three phone masts are operated using solar generated power
- 1,000 villagers gain access to electricity
- Health and climate risks are reduced
- Lighthouse project with high transferability

- Qualification of companies, energy suppliers and financing institutions in the financing and installation of photovoltaic systems
- Installation of a demonstration facility

- Photovoltaic systems contribute to the independent energy supply
- At least 50 experts are trained per year
- Financing instruments for investments in photovoltaics are available
- Companies utilize photovoltaic systems to increase their productivity



The project meets development policy objectives	> EUR 1 million annual turnover
 Complementarity of private- and public-sector objectives, profitability, and development benefits 	• > 10 employees
Subsidiarity: the project would not be implemented without the public sector contribution	Three years on the market
Competitive neutrality: project is open to all companies	Long-term involvement in partner country
 Private sector contribution: at least 50% of project costs 	Identifiable commercial interest on the part of the company
 Project is mainstreamed in the sustainable involvement of the company in the target country 	





Application deadlines



Companies should submit project proposals to their chosen partner by the end of the current application phase.

Application phases run from:

15 February to 31 March

15 May to 30 June

15 August to 30 September


15 November to 31 December

Participants	German and European companies and their subsidiaries	
Financial support	Up to 50% of costs (to a maximum of EUR 200,000) from BMZ funds	
Eligibility criteria	 Annual turnover of company must be over EUR 1 million Company must have more than ten employees Company must have been active in the market for at least three years Involvement in the partner country must be on a long-term basis 	
Application	Companies can submit project proposals as part of the quarterly ideas competition All information and documentation is available at www.develoPPP.de	
Strategic partnerships	Outstanding projects may receive more extensive funding as Strategic Development Partnerships that run in parallel with the ideas competitions
